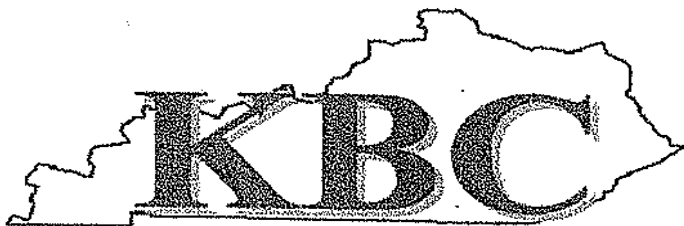

Changes In: Emissions Inventory Surveys

Letter from Division of Air Quality: November 19, 2008

The Department of Environmental Protection is committed to provide investments in Information Technology, which facilitate its missions of environmental stewardship. DEP is excited to announce the recent development of the Division for Air Quality (DAQ) Web-Survey, a web based application allowing facilities to submit required air emissions inventory survey data over the Internet. DEP believes that the DAQ Web Survey will improve quality data and enable more timely submissions of requested data.

To access the DAQ Web-Survey, all facilities to be surveyed must register at least one user with DEP. To register for access to the DAQ Web-Survey, please go to DEP's web site (<https://dep.gateway.ky.gov/eportal>). Note this is a secure web site and the URL must be preceded by https:// and must not include "www". If you are already an eNotification user, you must log on to the system and request access to the DAQ Web-Survey through the "Manage User" screen.

Registration as a user for DAQ Web-Survey requires you to accept a standard "User Agreement" before being approved as a registered user. Instructions for registration for the DAQ Web-Survey can be found by clicking the "User Help" link located in the upper corner of the web site. Once the registration request has been received, you will be contacted by a DEP staff member to verify information submitted. Upon approval, you will receive your logon ID and password. Using your logon ID and password, you must go back to the DEP'S web site and accept responsibility for the facilities assigned to you.

Our records indicate that your plant will be included by the DAQ to submit an air emissions inventory survey. Beginning with the upcoming air emissions inventory survey in January 2009, all surveys will be completed only using the DAQ Web-Survey and you must register as a user before the survey can be completed. **Please go to the website listed above and register a user by December 15, 2008.** In order for the process to be the most efficient, a high speed (broadband) Internet access is necessary. If you do not have access to a high speed Internet connection, check with your local public library for availability.

When Emissions Inventory Surveys for Calendar Year 2008 are available, you will receive notification by letter that your survey is available on the web site for completion.
